Marshal is responsible for helping to identify regulatory issues facing the life industry in New York, developing advocacy positions, and providing compliance support to member companies.

Before joining Debevoise, Marshal served as Deputy General Counsel for Insurance at the New York State Department of Financial Services, where he led the Department’s Office of General Counsel’s insurance team and provided legal advice to the Department’s leadership and business units. Previously, Marshal was Assistant Deputy Superintendent for Property, serving as second-in-command of the Department’s Property Bureau, where he supervised the Bureau’s regulatory work with a particular focus on financial and market conduct issues. In both roles, he worked closely with regulated entities, trade associations, and consumer groups on policy initiatives, including regulations and industry guidance.

Earlier in his career, Marshal worked at the State of Hawaii Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs Division of Financial Institutions, clerked for a Senior District Court Judge in the Southern District of New York, and was an insurance regulatory and corporate lawyer at Willkie Farr & Gallagher LLP. He is a graduate of Binghamton University and the University of Virginia School of Law.

“Having been an active Allied Professional member and having had the opportunity to provide counsel to LICONY on various regulatory issues, I am excited to now join the LICONY team,” said Marshal. “I look forward to working closely with our member companies, as well as the Department, on regulatory initiatives to help life insurers build a strong business environment in New York and to better serve New York life insurance policyholders.”
